### **Highlights:**

The only major reconsolidation planned for 2017 will be for the Case Law Digests: **Criminal Law** component of the Abridgment. We expect the reissue to comprise 54 volumes.

Taking into account the size and complexity of the Criminal Law title, we have used this reissue as an opportunity to significantly overhaul the classification scheme with the goal of reflecting important developments within the field as well as incorporating feedback from the judiciary, practioners and academics on how to best meet research needs with the revised scheme.

While we endeavour to provide you with the most accurate prices and publishing dates, it is not possible at this time to state with absolute certainty the number of volumes, month of publication, and price. All prices are estimates and may change. An outline of the 2017 program as it is currently planned follows, and we will keep you informed of any changes as the year unfolds.
