In the coming year, we plan reconsolidations for selected titles of the Case Law Digests component of the Abridgment. We plan to reissue the following titles:

- International Law
- International trade and customs
- Judges and courts
- Law enforcement agencies
- Maritime and admiralty law
- Personal property
- Personal property security
- Privacy and freedom of information
- Professions and occupations
- Time
- Torts
- **Transportation**

We also plan a reconsolidation for the Consolidated Table of Cases as it has not been reissued since 2011 and the supplements have become unmanageably large. The reissue is expected to comprise 33 volumes.

Effective September 3, 2019, we have simplified our invoice and your product price will now include standard shipping (previously shown as separate amounts). Accordingly, the estimated upkeep costs of our Abridgment products now include standard shipping.

While we endeavour to provide you with the most accurate prices and publishing dates, it is not possible at this time to state with absolute certainty the number of volumes, month of publication, and price. All prices are estimates and may change. An outline of the 2020 program as it is currently planned follows, and we will keep you informed of any changes as the year unfolds.
